


Estero Bay Senior Questionnaire



All the communities of Estero Bay are different, we know that services in one area are not met in others. - The results of both the Pre-Pandemic and Post Pandemic questions are shown in the following reports. We received a total of 313 reponses from both questionnarires in the comibined area of Los Osos, Morro Bay and Cayucos.


Introduction

- The data presented has been collected from the Estero Bay Senior Citizen Needs questionnaire. The questionnaire was distributed in September to the end of October from the Los Osos Cares Senior Program, to citizens in Los Osos, Morro Bay and Cayucos.
- The Post- pandemic questionnaire had a total of 103 respondents; there were 52 respondents from Los Osos, 34 respondents from Morro Bay and 17 respondents from Cayucos. The questionnaire consists of 10 separate questions. The first question asks the respondent what age bracket they belong to. The second asks respondents what their primary language is. The third question asks respondents which town they reside in. The fourth question asked respondents to write down what services or programs they currently use or have used in the past. The fifth questions asks respondents to choose what services or programs they could benefit from. The sixth question asks where they go for daily news. The seventh question asks whether they have a emergency contact or not. The eighth questions asks respondents if they or their spouse is a veteran. The ninth question asks if they have a disability or not. The tenth question asks if they have the ability to use the internet. The tables presented reflect the percentages that were calculated from the number of respondents that pertain to each town in regards to questions one, two, three, six, seven, eight, nine and ten. The graphs presented reflect the percentages that were calculated from total number of respondents that pertain to each town in regards to questions four and five.


Percent Services Requested by Senior Citizens







